



Our Story

Puerto Rico Disaster Releaf - Will deploy trained teams to deliver supplies and assist communities in Rural Bayamon and Guaynabo areas to gain access to emergency services, clear debris, and prepare for more hurricanes. The Team will work with local governments and agencies to identify supply recipients. David Serrano of Puerto Rico, now a Colorado resident and trained military Veteran will lead the team.

Our Mission

Deliver supplies to community centers in Bayamon and Guaynabo. Clear roads of debris, provide assistance to residents in clearing land and homes of debris; and conduct food, fuel, and water runs to and from rural mountain areas and Catano (fuel port). Our efforts are to assist with the rebuild of the island

Logistics

- Operations – Coordinates two teams on the island in 21-day deployments (commitment for 2-4 months)
 - Based in Denver, CO but with support by individuals from Florida to New York to Denver, including governmental support on the island
 - Teams Missions
 - Assist with logistics for disaster relief including but not limited to clearing roads, search and rescue, resource procurement, needs assessment, transportation, and more
 - The teams are tapped in to local governments performing resource assessments, and have access to FEMA, American Red Cross and other assets in San Juan
 - Operations is responsible for the following:
 - Team resource procurement, supply procurement (donations and paid), supply distribution, flight procurement, personnel procurement, logistics, and more
 - Puerto Rico community resource assessment, resources procurement (donations and paid) supply chain administration and logistics, transportation procurement, ground distribution of supplies, and more
- Fiduciary Agent / Financial accountability: Disaster Releaf is a project of the DoingGood Foundation, a 501c3 public charity, based in Denver, CO, TAX ID 42-175876
 - DoingGood Foundation will purchase approved items, pay all fee's and cost related to the mission and create financial controls around donations and asset procurement
 - Use of Proceeds: No salaries and no admin or management fees. Capital will pay for Transportation cost, supplies, gear/tools, equipment, for aid workers and coordination and delivery of supplies for communities in Puerto Rico, outside San Juan
